Concurrent Enrollment

- ▶ SVVSD will pay the tuition for up to two college classes each semester at FRCC or Aims CC
 - Earn college and high school credit
- ▶ Classes must be pre-approved by counselor, principal and SVVSD Director of Curriculum
- ▶ Classes must align with you ICAP (Naviance)
- ▶ Classes cannot meet after 6:30pm or weekends
- ▶ You must earn a C or better, otherwise you will have to reimburse SVVSD for the cost of tuition
- ▶ Online college classes – Aims CC only

Concurrent Enrollment Options

- Front Range Community College at Mead HS
 - COM 115 – Public Speaking
 - Mon/Wed – A3/B7
 - ASL 122 – American Sign Language 2 (B or better in ASL 121)
 - Tue/Thur/Fri – A2/B6 or A3/B7
 - SOC 101 – Intro to Sociology
 - Mon/Wed – A3/B7 or A4/B8
- Front Range Community College – Longmont campus
 - Search class schedule for classes taught at the Boulder County campus
- Aims Community College at Mead HS
 - CRJ 135 – Judicial Function
 - 3rd quarter – Mon/Tue/Wed/Thur – A1/B5
 - CRJ 145 – Correctional Process
 - 4th quarter – Mon/Tue/Wed/Thur – A1/B5
- Aims Community College
 - Search class schedule for online classes or classes taught at the Greeley or Ft. Lupton campus

Concurrent Enrollment Process Returning Students

Returning = You are currently taking a college class

1. Complete the online SVVSD Concurrent Enrollment Agreement form (10 digit SASID)
2. Print, Sign and SVVSD Submit Concurrent Enrollment form to Mr. Elliott by **November 10th**
3. FRCC: Register for your college classes using the CRN #'s provided through your eWolf account by **December 1st**
 - Use the FRCC class schedule to register for college classes held on the FRCC Boulder County campus
4. AIMS CC: Aims CC staff will register you for CRJ 135 and CRJ 145. You have to register for any online college classes by **December 1st**

Concurrent Enrollment Process New Students

New= You are NOT currently taking a college class


1. Complete the online SVVSD Concurrent Enrollment Agreement form (10 digit SASID)
2. Print, Sign and SVVSD Submit Concurrent Enrollment form to Mr. Elliott by **Nov 10**
3. **APPLY** for admission to FRCC or Aims CC
 - Complete the College Opportunity Fund (COF) and the CiC Worksheet
4. AIMS CC: Complete and submit the “Under 18” form
5. FRCC: Register for your college classes using the CRN #'s provided through your eWolf account by **Dec 1**
 - Use the FRCC class schedule to register for college classes held on the FRCC Boulder County campus
6. AIMS CC: Aims staff will register you for CRJ 135 and CRJ 145. You have to register for any online college classes by **Dec 1**.

Deadlines

November 10

- ▶ Meet with your counselor to discuss Concurrent Enrollment options
- ▶ Complete online SVVSD Concurrent Enrollment Agreement
 - After applying, you'll receive an email with the completed form attached
- ▶ Print, Sign and Submit Concurrent Enrollment Agreement form to Mr. Elliott

December 1

- ▶ Apply for admission to FRCC/Aims CC
 - ▶ Complete the COF (FRCC only) and the CiC worksheet
 - ▶ Register for your college classes at FRCC (eWolf) or Aims (MyAims)
