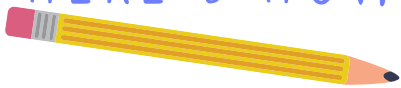


COLLEGE READINESS

HERE'S HOW:



Every 9th, 10th and 11th grade student takes a PSAT/SAT practice test.



The current freshman class will have had 6 practice tests by the time they are ready to take the SAT their Junior year!



The practice tests are taken in November and February on a late start day.



In January or February, students have the opportunity in their Mav30 classes to learn how to analyze their results in all three areas of testing; reading, math, and writing. They are able to identify their strengths and weaknesses and will use their results and analytical skills to improve their scores.



Juniors have an additional opportunity to participate in an SAT Prep Seminar class with the Sycamore Learning Company. The seminar is a 5-hour session where students will learn how to further analyze the test as they take it and will leave with a deeper understanding of how to prepare.



April is official state PSAT/SAT testing month! 9th and 10th-grade students will take the PSAT test April 10th and 11th-grade students will take the SAT on April 9th. SAT make-ups are April 23rd. .
